Q-mark - European Quality Label for Youth Work. The Best Methods for Tackling Youth Radicalization

Budapest, 11 September 2018

Subjective Values Foundation is organizing an international conference titled *Q-mark - European Quality Label for Youth Work. The Best Methods for Tackling Youth Radicalization* within the framework of the KA2 Erasmus Plus project titled *Stop Youth Radicalization - StopR* (Agreement n° 2017-1-HU01-KA205-035478).

The conference is organized in support of anti-radicalization organizations. We are introducing an innovative online platform (<http://stopr.eu>), through which such organizations have the opportunity to (1) share their methodological achievements in a structured and recognizable manner; (2) receive an external evaluation of their methods in the form of a Quality Mark (Q-mark) Certificate and be highlighted as holders of a quality mark that will raise their reputation and visibility across Europe; and (3) establish connections with other quality mark holders and engage in transnational projects on development of new training methods and formats. Through these effects the platform aims to increase the level of professionalism of youth organisations and connect professionals working in the field of anti-radicalization all over Europe.

During the day of the conference, members of anti-radicalization organizations will have the opportunity to familiarize themselves with the platform's potential and see first-hand its functions. The Q-mark conference will also serve as a meeting hub for experts working in the field of radicalization with presentations from both Hungarian and international experts regarding the status of youth radicalization in Europe.
